Our prices do not include disbursement fees paid on your behalf to third parties, for example; Crematorium, Churches, officiant's, flowers etc. We will provide you with an itemised estimate of costs and will require a deposit payment for the full cost of the disbursements a minimum of 3 working days prior to the funeral taking place. The balance of the account will be invoiced approximately seven days after the funeral, with payment required within 30 days of the invoice date, after which, you may be charged interest until payment is received in full. We are not authorised or regulated to provide payment plans.

DISBURSEMENT CHARGES 2023

These charges are made by third parties and are subject to change at any time. It is customary for us to pay these on your behalf, presenting you with one invoice for the total cost of your chosen funeral. Options vary according to your personalised wishes but may commonly include;
